- 2. Presentation by Core Capital Campaign Provider- Linda Buskirk
 - 2.1 The work we have done for the rector is helpful for our capital campaign in the future. Linda invited us to visit the website (see materials) Linda believes in this work because she sees how it transforms a congregation. It helps bring them together. As a community, they accomplish things they never thought they could financially.
